102.10 PURPOSES

LNRA was created as a conservation and reclamation district in 1941 pursuant to the provisions of Article 16, Section 59 of the Texas Constitution. LNRA's boundaries are co-extensive with the boundaries of Jackson County, Texas. LNRA was created for the purpose of (i) controlling, storing, preserving and distributing the storm floodwaters, and the waters of the rivers and streams of Jackson County, and their tributaries, for all useful and beneficial purposes and (ii) providing associated recreation, fishing and wildlife facilities for the health and enjoyment of Jackson County citizens and the visiting public.
